

# What Families Need to Know About Financing Your DePaul Cristo Rey Education

## How do I know if my family's income qualifies my student for acceptance at DePaul Cristo Rey?

- DePaul Cristo Rey is for students whose families need significant financial assistance to afford a private school.
- All families who apply to DPCR must complete the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment form. An outside organization reviews this form and sends us the results which are used to determine financial eligibility for acceptance.
- FACTS and DPCR take many factors in addition to family income into consideration in admitting students including family size, significant health care expenses or employment changes.

## How much does tuition cost?

- Families pay different amounts of tuition at DePaul Cristo Rey depending on their financial need.
- Each student's tuition amount is decided on a case-by-case basis after each family has completed the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment Form.
- Based on FACTS, tuition amounts range from \$500 to the full tuition of \$6,000. However, very few families pay \$6,000.

## Do you accept EdChoice Scholarships?

- Yes! Please submit your EdChoice application or renewal paperwork to DPCR as soon as possible after you register your student.
- Our Admissions Team can help families find out if they're eligible for EdChoice.

## Do I have to complete the FACTS form every year?

- Families only have to complete the FACTS form one time for each student.
- Every family is required to provide a copy of your family's tax return each year.



## When I find out my annual tuition cost, do I have to pay it all at once?

- No family is expected to pay tuition in one payment.
- DePaul Cristo Rey partners with Smart Tuition to manage our tuition payments.
- Through Smart Tuition, families make 10 monthly tuition payments from September to May.
- Families can pay through Smart Tuition by check, credit card or by debit from your checking or savings account.
- Payments can be made by mail, by phone, through a secure website, or via a mobile app.
- Families can also pay in cash in person at DePaul Cristo Rey.

## I thought students earn their tuition through the Corporate Work Study Program. Why is there additional tuition?

- Students earn \$7,500 through the Corporate Work Study Program, which offsets a portion of the full \$13,500 cost of a DPCR education.
- The remaining \$6,000 is covered through tuition, financial aid and EdChoice, if the student is eligible.

## Are there fees in addition to tuition?

- There are \$300 in fees per student:
  - \$50 nonrefundable registration fee when you enroll
  - \$50 student fee
  - \$200 technology fee to offset the cost of each student's laptop computer.
- These payments can be made with initial registration or made monthly.
- If you choose to pay these fees monthly, they will be included with your Smart Tuition payment plan.

## What if my family's financial situation changes and we need additional tuition assistance?

- Please call or stop in the Business Office as soon as possible if we need to re-evaluate your circumstances. We can't help you if you don't talk to us!

### Application/Fees

#### November 30, 2018 **Priority Admissions Deadline to complete:**

- DPCR Application and all required paperwork
- FACTS form online (Admissions staff can help you with this form)

#### January 16, 2019 **Watch your Mailbox**

- Admission letters and tuition/financial aid explanations are mailed.

#### February 5, 2019 **Class of 2023 Registration Opens**

- \$50 registration fee due at enrollment.

#### September 2019 **First tuition payment due through Smart Tuition**

February 1, 2019 **Contact Admissions to determine if you are eligible for EdChoice.**

Upon Enrollment **Submit EdChoice application or renewal to DPCR.**
